Owls have two legs. They have sharp	-			

claws on their feet called talons. Their
beak curves down and is hooked at
the end. They have two wings and
a short tail.
Habitat
Owls can be found all over the world,
but they do not live in Antarctica.
They live in many different habitats
such as forests and deserts.
Some owls live in man-made places.
Barn owls like to live in barns or
other empty buildings.
Many owls live in trees but they are
not very good at making nests. Owls
find nests made by other birds. Nests
built by hawks or crows make good
nests for owls. They can also live in
holes in trees.
Sometimes owls can be hard to see.
The colours and patterns on their
feathers help them to blend into the
background. This is called camouflage.

Food
Owls are birds of prey. They use
their sharp talons and beaks to hunt
for food. Owls are meat eaters. They

eat small mammals such as mice,		
rabbits or squirrels.		
Owls can also eat other small animals		
like fish, lizards and insects. Some		
owls like to hide their food in trees		
or behind rocks. They eat the food a		
day or two later.

Female owls lay 1 to 14 eggs. The		
eggs are round and white. The mother		
owl sits on the eggs to keep them		
warm. Baby owls hatch out of the		
eggs after 3 to 5 weeks.		
Baby owls are called owlets. The		
owlets are covered in soft white		
feathers. These feathers start to turn		
brown or grey after a few days.
